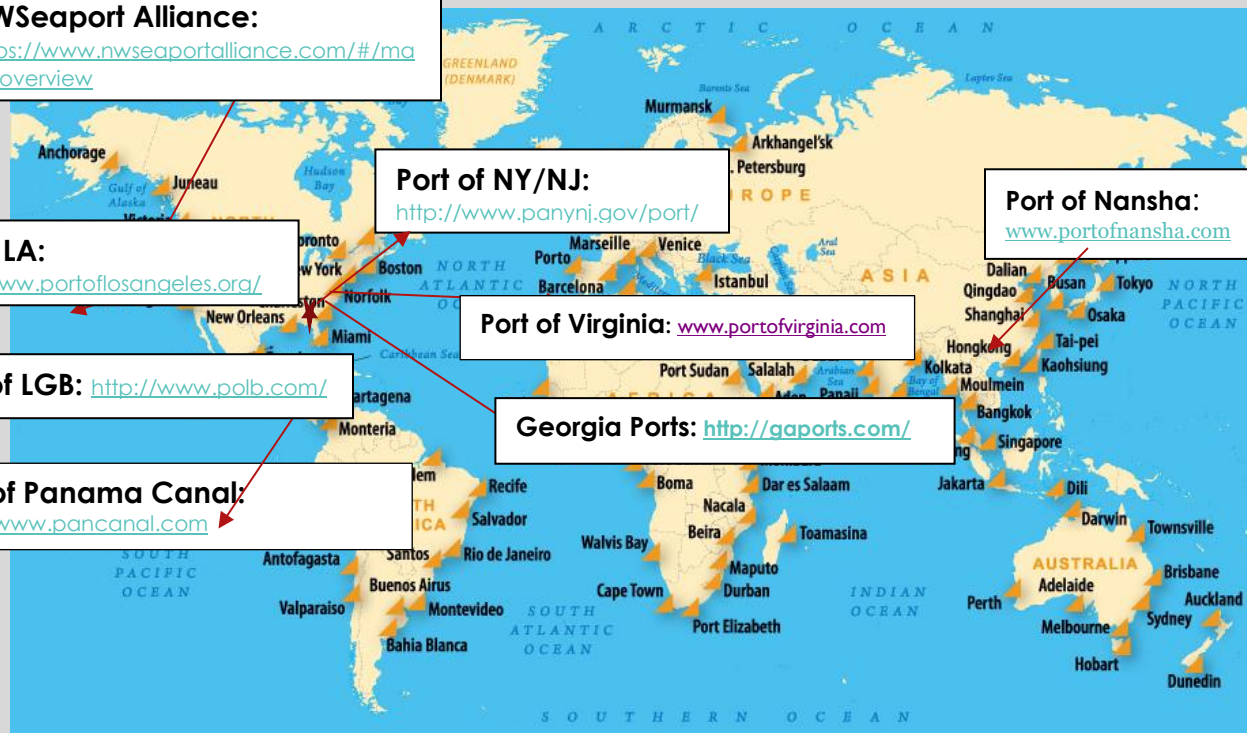

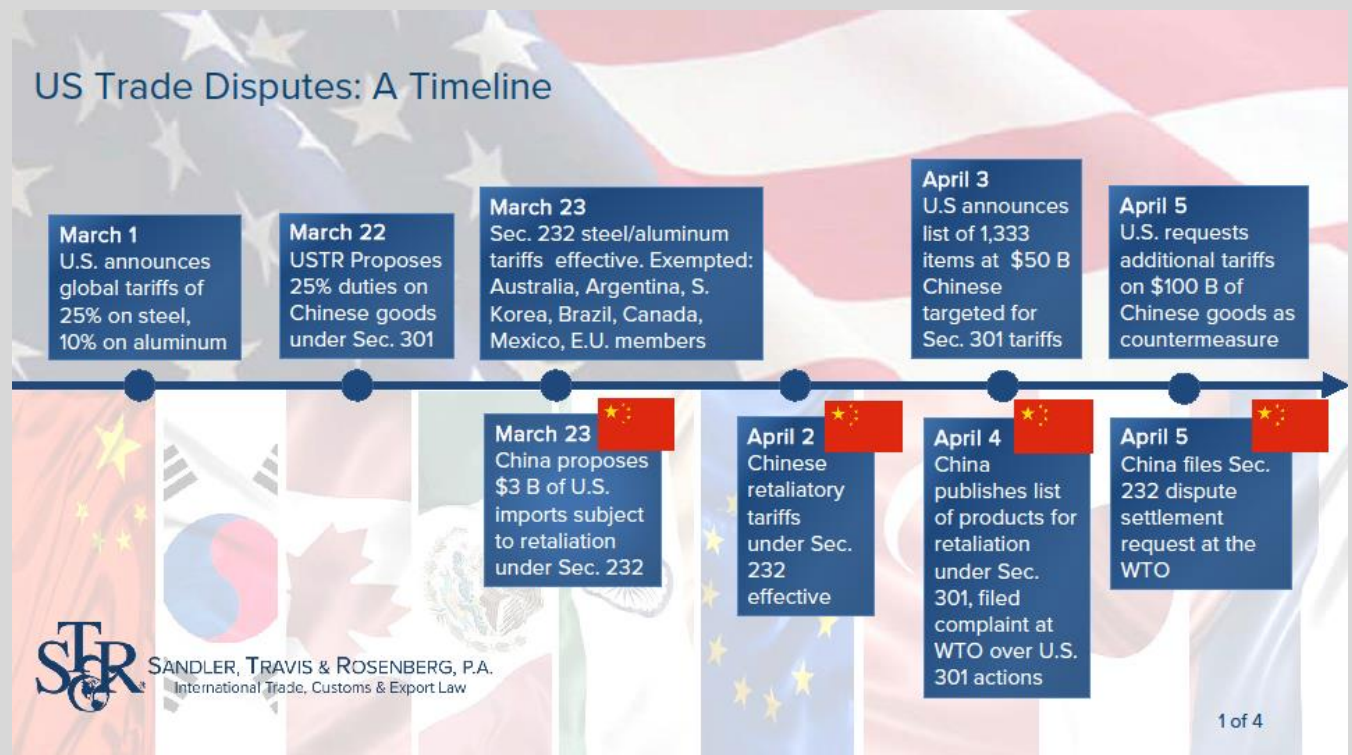

Here is the Trade Actions timeline in follow-up to my Trade Legislative Update given at this year's Columbus Logistics Conference.

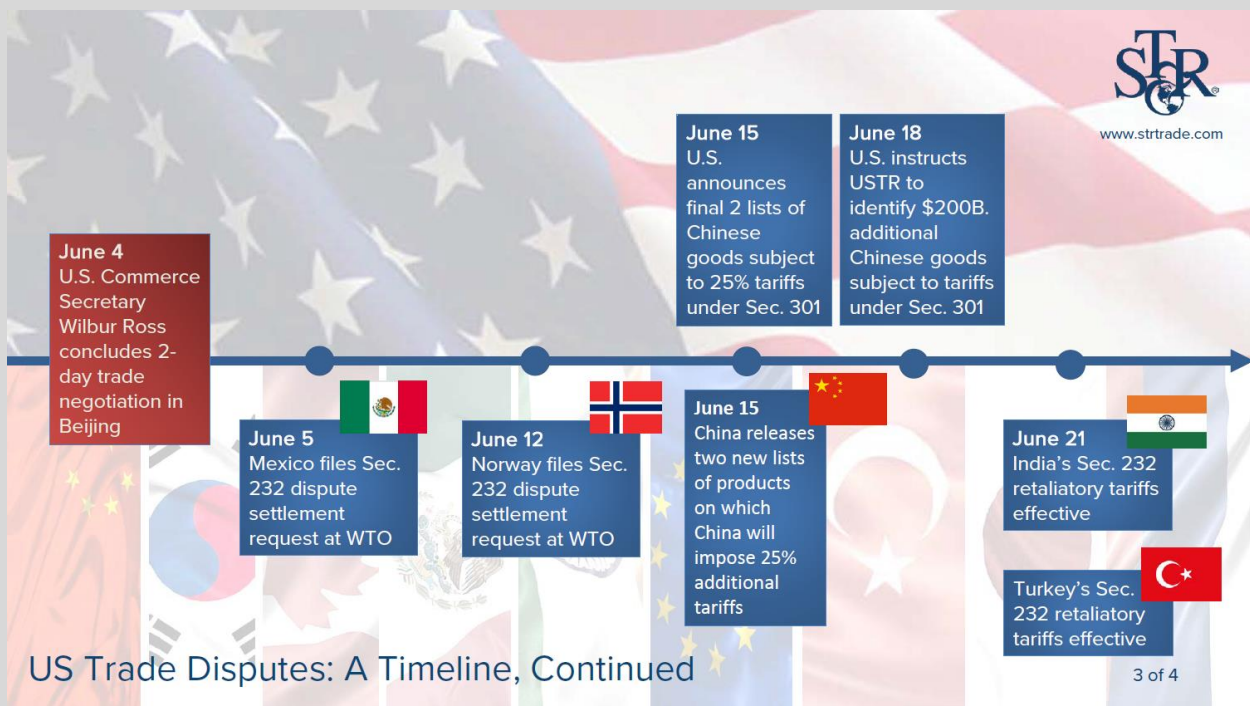
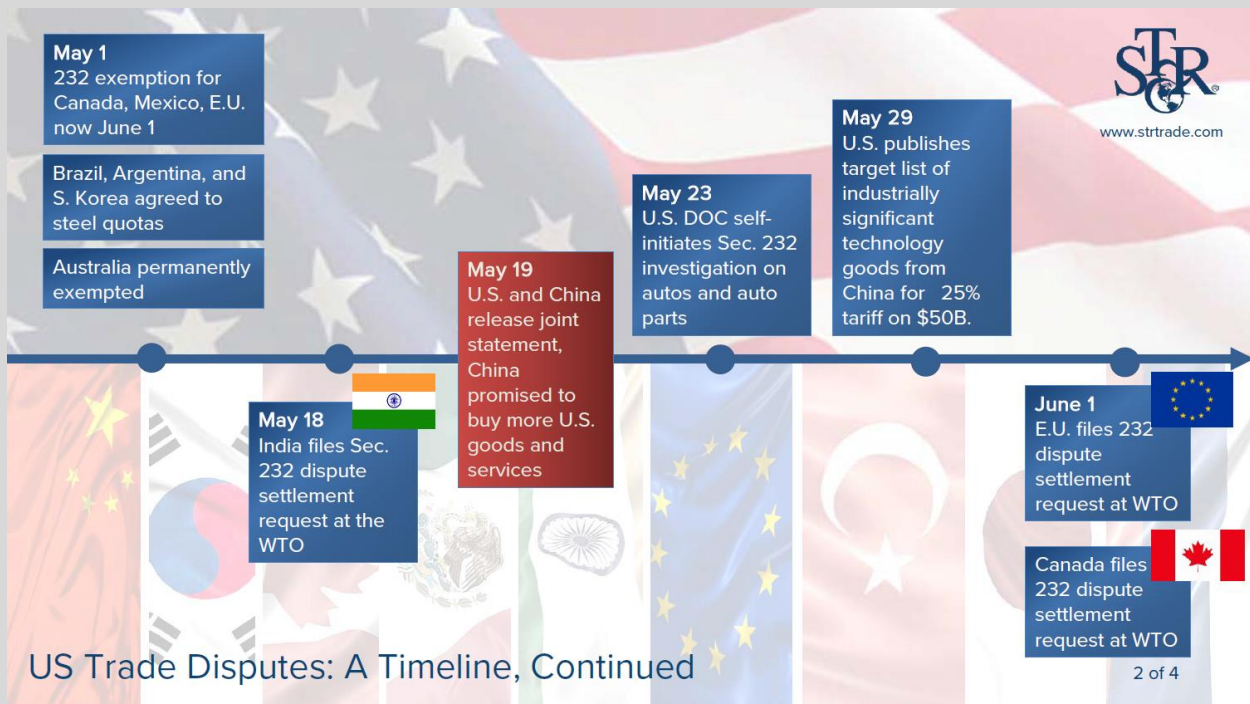

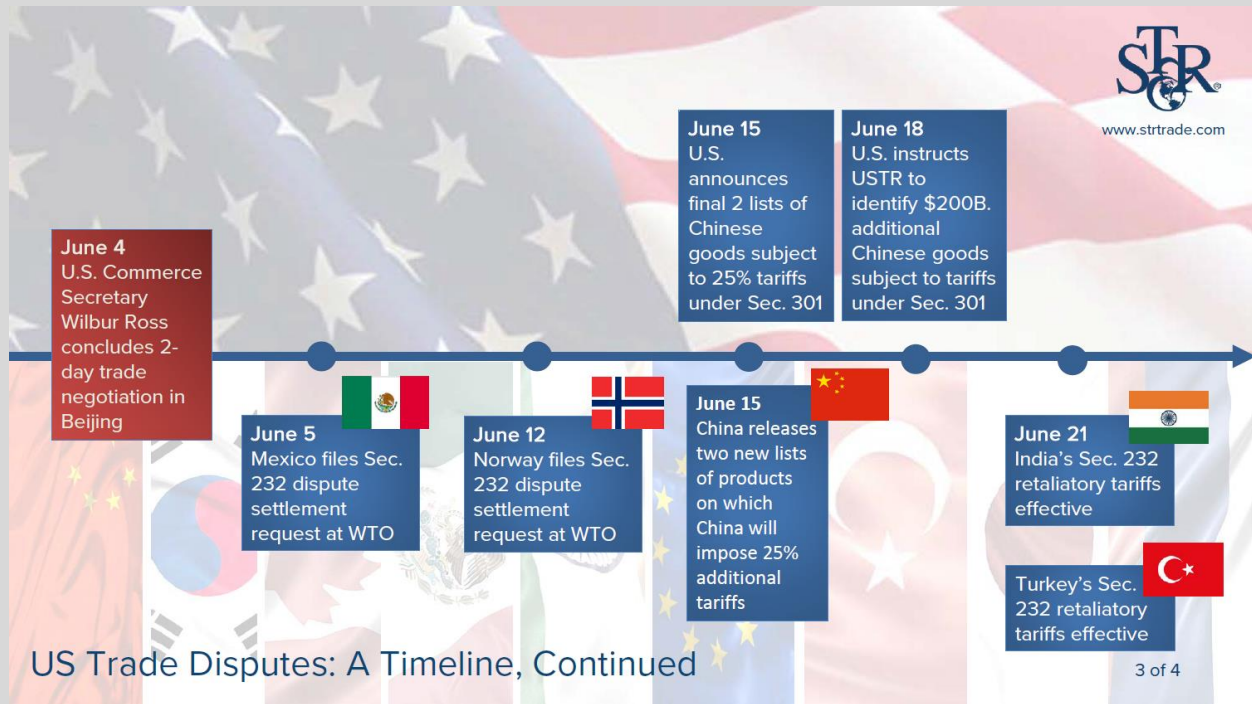
