Nomenclature

The recommended nomenclature is meant to build North American International Freight shorthand when appropriate. Rickenbacker Inland Port should no longer be used in any or informal communications, though casual references to the "Rickenbacker area" may still be used internally when talking about assets in that location.

First, it's important to clarify what comprises the North American International Freight Center. The North American International Freight Center refers to the collection of logistics assets in the 11-county Columbus Region, including: equity in the Center name, while addressing the need for formal
