

United Airlines to offer nonstop flights between Columbus and San Francisco, its gateway to the Asia Pacific

COLUMBUS – United Airlines today announced the addition of daily nonstop flights to San Francisco International Airport (SFO) from John Glenn Columbus International Airport (CMH) beginning in June. Available for booking now, the new air service increases West Coast access from Ohio's capital city and opens up a world of international travel options.

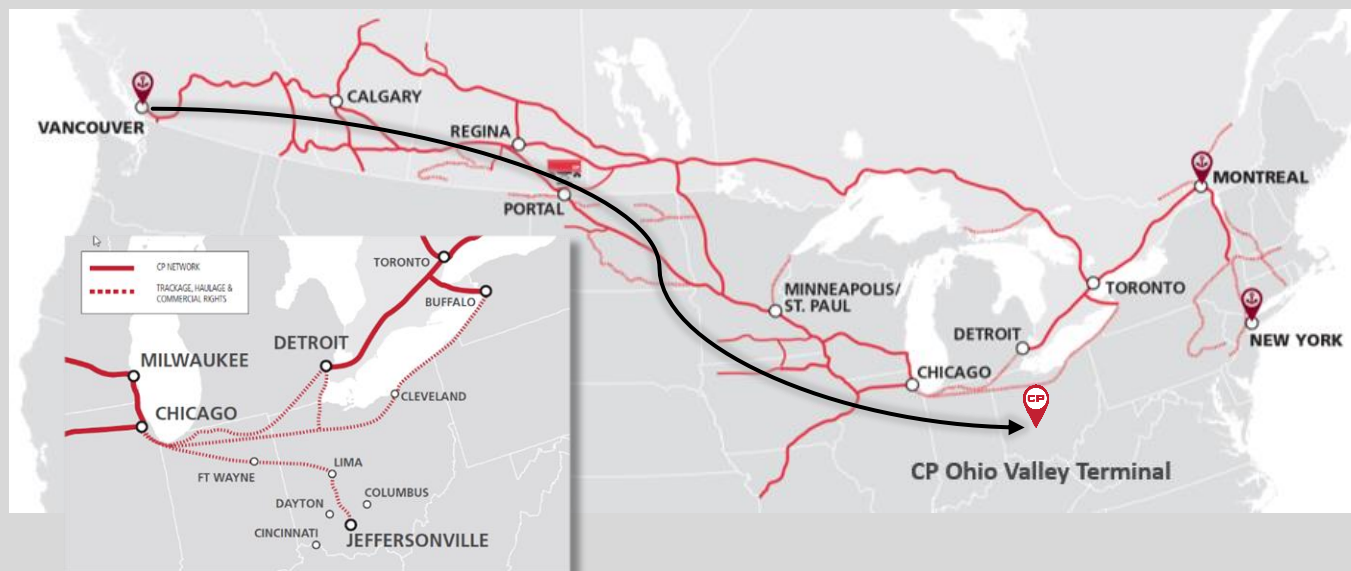
